

# Download China State Council Tariffs

China's State Council has confirmed that it will temporarily suspend an extra tariff on U.S. car imports, reducing the tariff rate from the current 40 percent to 15 percent, the South China Morning Post reported Dec. 14. On April 1, 2018, the Ministry of Finance (MOF) announced that with the approval of the State Council, the Customs Tariff Commission of the State Council has decided to suspend duty concessions on ...
